SUBJECT:

Approve Map and Legal Description, and Adopt a Proposed Resolution for the Annexation of Parcel No. U-8-19-2 to Improvement District No. U-8 (Twisted Tendril Vineyard, LLC)

BACKGROUND:

In accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 2063.7, the Board established standard terms and conditions for the annexation of lands to an Improvement District of Eastern Municipal Water District. The proposed Resolution annexing Parcel No. U-8-19-2 to Improvement District No. U-8 (sewer) is attached as (Exhibit A). The parcel is located in an Unincorporated Territory, County of Riverside, as depicted on the attached legal description and map (Exhibit B). EMWD has received a signed petition from the current property owner, Twisted Tendril Vineyard, LLC, with Gerald A. Heiner as the Manager. All necessary ownership documentation are on file with the District.

Financial Stability: Enhance and maintain the EMWD’s strong financial position and credit quality by identifying and implementing specific opportunities to improve underlying financial metrics.


